## City of Euless Privacy Policy

The City of Euless Utility Billing Office is committed to the privacy of its customers. All City employees are responsible for safeguarding customer information and such information is used for business purposes only. Customers may control the release of account information except as required by Texas Utilities Code Ch. 182. The City of Euless Utility Billing Office strives to ensure that the information obtained and used is accurate.

Customer Driver's License and Social Security numbers are used for identification purposes only. When a customer asks for account information, whether via phone or in person, he/she may be asked to verify one or both of these numbers. If a customer's spouse or roommate asks for information on the account, whether via phone or in person, he/she may be asked to verify one or both of their Driver's License or Social Security numbers.

Customer information may be used by a third party collection agency contracted with the City of Euless to collect delinquent accounts.

Someone outside the City of Euless may request customer information. Under Texas Utilities Code Ch. 182, individuals/consumers may sign a confidentiality form or send a written confidentiality request. If such a request is received, information such as customer address, telephone number, and consumption information will not be released except to a consumer reporting agency, other utility companies or any state or federal government and their subcontractors.

Information entered into the Customer Master files remains in the account database and is only accessible to authorized staff working for the City of Euless. All written information including copies is secured within the Utility Billing Office and shredded for destruction.

**AUTHORIZATION TO RELEASE INFORMATION:** The City of Euless can withhold the release of your residential consumption, address, and telephone number with your written authorization. Please indicate your preference by placing an X in the appropriate blank.

## Indoor Pool Grand Opening

January 4, 9 a.m. – noon

EFLAP, 300 W. Midway Dr.

Please join us for the grand opening of the latest addition to the Euless Family Life Center. The indoor pool, which is accessible from both the Senior Center and the Fitness Center, will feature three 21 meter lap lanes, a fifteen foot long Resistance River and a slide. In order to provide good air quality, large translucent doors are located around the perimeter of the facility. These doors open when needed to provide natural ventilation and allow fresh air to flow through so that the strong chlorine smell is diminished. The unique design allows the heat and humidity to escape, yet keep the environment at a comfortable temperature. In addition, semi-translucent roof panels provide light. These features help to reduce energy consumption.

American Red Cross certified lifeguards and instructors will teach a variety of lessons year-round. Water aerobics ranging from arthritic aerobics, to cardio aerobics, to yoga and Pilates, will be taught six days a week. Water safety instructors will offer swim lessons to adults, preschoolers and toddlers. Drill team classes will be offered to help residents prepare to participate in a swim team. There will also be time for open swim and lap times throughout the week. The indoor pool is also available for parties and rentals. For more information, please call 817-685-1681.

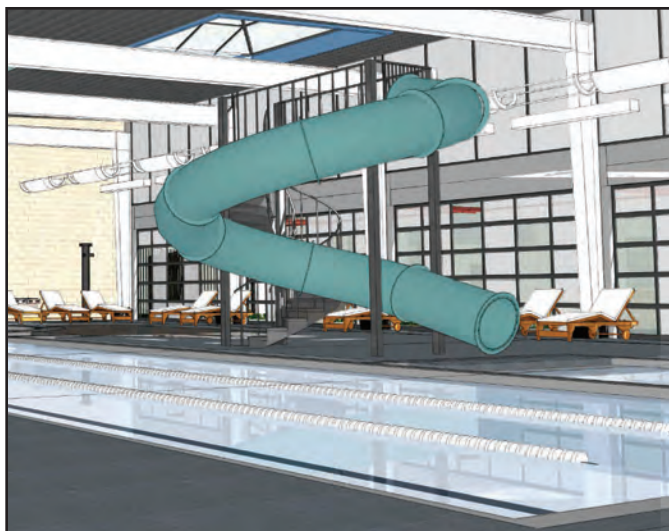

Residents may dispose of LIVE Christmas trees only (with no ornaments or lights) at the designated area of Midway Park from December 26 - January 4. On January 4 the city will host a tree mulching demonstration and will give away bags of mulch and tree saplings to the public.
